Included are Dom Jean Leclercq's classic *Alone with God* and *A Humanist Hermit*.

Spiritual conferences on the life "hidden with Christ in God" (Col 3:3), plus a study of "The Monastic Experience of St. Romuald". The anonymous author shares the fruits of over 30 years of Camaldolese dedication.

The Eremitic Life: Encountering God in Silence and Solitude. By Fr. Cornelius Wencel, Er. Cam. 2007, 225 pages, \$14. The Polish author is a devoted student of modern theology, especially the thought of Von Balthasar. This is a general portrait of the hermit life aimed at the contemporary layman.
